Letter From the Rav

Letter From the Rav

Avigdor and Dovid Srulovich have served as models of helping with *tzorchei tzibbur* at a stage of life when it is not yet expected. They help with the Shul *Kiddush* and with other needs without expectation of recognition, and their generosity of spirit is a real inspiration to all of us. Great credit is due to their parents, Yoav and Reena, for instilling in Avigdor and Dovid the importance of helping others and supporting the *tzibbur*.

These honorees share a common denominator: commitment to the *tzibbur* and utilization of their talents to benefit others. This characteristic defines them and animates them.

The Sefas Emes discerns this ideal in the Mishna (Avos 1:14) in which Hillel said אם אין אני לי מי לי וכשאני – "if I am not for myself, who is for me, but if I am for myself, what am I". He states that every person has unique capabilities, and only that person is able to utilize these gifts – "if I do not fulfill my own potential, no one else can do this in my place". At the same time, if the individual uses those abilities solely for self-advancement and gain, one has forfeited the opportunity and responsibility of channeling one's personal capacities to help others – "but if I use my talents for myself, what am I"?

In this light, the *Sefas Emes* also illuminates a Midrash, which cites Dovid Hamelech as saying רבש"ע בכל יום ויום הייתי מחשב ואומר למקום פלוני ולבית דירה פלונית אני בכל יום ויום הייתי מחשב ואומר למקום פלוני ולבתי מדרשות – "every day I would consider going to a specific location or residence, but my feet would take me to Shuls and *Batei Midrash*".

According to the Sefas Emes, Dovid describes his initial inclination to focus on his own achievements, but finds that he is pulled instead to the Bais Knesses and Bais Medrash, where the tzibbur gathers and all the participants support one another and advance the interests of the tzibbur. There, Dovid discovers his calling and attains fulfillment. This truly captures the distinctive trait of our honorees.

We should all continue to use our collective capabilities and resources to continue to elevate our *Mikdash Me'at*, and be able to be *Mekadesh Shem Shomayim*.




